

US Coast Guard Auxiliary Incident Response

Recommended Emergency Bag Contents (including items ordinarily needed for operations)

Food/Water

Bottled Water/sports drinks
Peanut Butter & Jelly (squeezables) & bread
Power bars/granola bars
Source of quick sugar-Candy

Personal Gear

Personal medications (copy of prescriptions)
Common OTC meds (esp. antacids & Imodium)
Personal needs kit (soap, shampoo, towel, tooth brush, tooth paste, hair brush)
Bug spray/suntan lotion
Spare eye glasses (with retention strap)
Sunglasses
Small sewing kit with safety pins
Spare car/boat keys
Printed list of emergency phone numbers
Wallet, **AUXILIARY ID**

Operational Gear

Uniform(s) (ODU/Working Blue) includes pants, belt, shirts, ball cap, socks, boots, blousing straps
Change of clothes & undergarments & socks
Change of shoes
Sweat shirt or fleece
PPE
SAR Vest (rigged, or the equipment that it should contain loaded elsewhere)
PFD plus Float Coat/Mustang/Dry Suit (as appropriate)
Pepirb
Flashlight
Foul weather gear
Gloves
Cell phone, DC charger
PDA or other handheld
Portable GPS
Hand held marine radio. DC charger
Spare rechargeable batteries and small charger
Stop watch
Charts, maps, pen, pencils, dividers & plotter
Travel alarm (with am/fm radio)
Digital camera or disposable camera
