



## Outlines of PQS

**Assistant Container Inspector** – Qualified members will hold minimum competencies to complete exterior Container Inspection, including a review of both the transportation markings/papers and external container integrity. Qualified members will work as part of an Inspection Team.

**Assistant Pollution Investigator** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies to assist a qualified Pollution Investigator in completing a Pollution Investigation Case.

**Assistant Harbor Safety Specialist** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies to assist a qualified Harbor Safety Officer in conducting a wide variety of Port Safety and Security tasks.

**Assistant Pollution Response Specialist** – Qualified members will hold minimum competencies to assist a qualified FOSCR in an Oil Pollution Response.

**Assistant Facility Inspector** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies to complete a routine Facility Inspection under supervision.

**Assistant Liferaft Inspector** – Qualified members will hold minimum competencies to inspect liferafts and their associated equipment in all routine periodic tests.

**Marine Environmental Education Specialist** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies to act as a Marine Environmental Education Specialist providing short duration (8 hours or less) seminars on selected Marine Environmental Protection topics to a wide range of audiences.

**Administrative and Management Specialist** – This is intended to be a professional development tool for all Auxiliarist interested in serving in a post above FSO-MS but it not a requirement for such posts.

**Marine Safety Watchstander** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies necessary to complete a Marine Safety Watch.

**Uninspected Passenger Vessel Examiner** – Qualified members will hold the minimum competencies to examine Uninspected Passenger Vessels and the associated equipment for compliance with the applicable safety regulations in 46 CFR subchapter C.

**Commercial Fishing Vessel Program** – Qualified members will promote safe practices in the commercial fishing industry through voluntary examinations of fishing vessels. Positions include: Commercial Fishing Vessel Examiner and Commercial Fishing Vessel Dockwalker.
